**I. Call to Order**

**IV. Approval of Minutes from Last Meeting**

- Scheduling In-service for June 1st, and looking to get the new Assistant Managers Lifeguard Instructor Certified. NGPC approved costs associated with both items.
- Working on collecting staff clearances and working permits for 2025 season

**VII. Facility Manager's Report-Jim**

- Pool is drained and grounds/facilities preparation is underway.
- Marsh pool restoration-handling minor repairs; additional work may be needed in the fall.
- New PA system has been installed-reviewing options for how NGAC can use for meets.
- Still waiting on timeline for the catwalk installation over the DE filter tub. May need to wait until fall or find a different vendor depending on timeline proposed.
- Filter material changing from DE to Pearlite.
- Jim noted that the groundwater pumped from the pool flooded the gravel area behind the grounds, which is a cause for concern with NGPC and UGT. Jim and Harry to work with

UGT to discuss possible solutions.

**VIII. Secretary's Report**

- Amendments to be made to NGAC lease agreement and sent out shortly.
- Once clearances/work permits are all collected will contact school districts.

**IX. Registration Update**

- 204 spots left; 7 memberships waiting for verification.
- Theresa and/or Harry will turn off registration when needed.
